

AtoShip Shipping for Magento 2 Installation Guide

Version 1.0.0

1. Requirements

- Magento 2.4.4 or later (Open Source, Commerce, or Cloud)
- PHP 8.1 or later

2. Installation via Composer

The recommended way to install the extension is via Composer:

```
composer require atoship/module-shipping
bin/magento module:enable Atoship_Shipping
bin/magento setup:upgrade
bin/magento cache:flush
```

3. Manual Installation

1. Download **atoship-for-magento.zip** from <https://atoship.com/docs/integrations/magento>
2. Extract the archive to `app/code/Atoship/Shipping/`
3. Run the following commands:

```
bin/magento module:enable Atoship_Shipping
bin/magento setup:upgrade
bin/magento cache:flush
```

4. Configuration

Navigate to **Stores > Configuration > Sales > AtoShip Shipping** in your Magento admin panel.

General Settings

- **Enable**
Enable or disable the extension (default: **Yes**)
- **Webhook Secret**

HMAC-SHA256 secret copied from your AtoShip dashboard

- **Debug Logging**

Log webhook payloads to `var/log/atoship.log` (default: **No**)

Tracking Settings

- **Auto Complete on Delivery**

Automatically set order status to Complete when the package is delivered (default: **Yes**)

- **Notify Customer on Ship**

Send an email notification to the customer when a label is purchased (default: **Yes**)

- **Notify Customer on Delivery**

Send an email notification to the customer when the package is delivered (default: **Yes**)

5. Webhook Setup

In your AtoShip dashboard (<https://atoship.com>), set the webhook URL to:

```
https://your-store.com/atoship/webhook/receive
```

Copy the webhook secret from the dashboard and paste it in the Magento configuration (Stores > Configuration > Sales > AtoShip Shipping > **Webhook Secret**).

Supported webhook events:

- `label.created`
- `label.purchased`
- `label.voided`
- `tracking.updated`
- `tracking.delivered`
- `tracking.exception`

6. Verification

After installation, verify everything is working:

- **Check module status** — `bin/magento module:status | grep Atoship`
- **Check configuration page** — Admin > Stores > Configuration > Sales > AtoShip Shipping
- **Test webhook** — Send a test event from your AtoShip dashboard
- **Check logs** — `var/log/atoship.log` (when debug mode is enabled)
